RULES AND REGULATIONS

When you fill out an application form you agree to the following rules and regulations.

Enforcement of these guidelines is the responsibility of the citizens of McMinn County and of Riceville and we ask that participants take this responsibility seriously to ensure we have something to pass on to our children and community in the years to come.

RULES:

- All participants must register with Riceville Utility District and follow the guidelines to ensure a safe environment and to help keep our community clean. Registering will also ensure you a location to set up.
- Parking is first come first serve.
- Booths are the space marked on the floor (12x15) and numbered. Please adhere to your space and number and allow room for a walk way down the middle of the pavilion.
- As per stipulations set for this property, yard sales (outside of HWY 11S SPECIAL EVENT) are not allowed on property.
- Participants assume all responsibility for any losses of property.
- Per Tennessee state law, please refrain from smoking in the pavilions, as children may be present.
- All necessary equipment and displays must be provided by the vendor. We do not provide chairs, tables or tents.
- Each participant is responsible for maintaining his/her area in a clean and neat manner throughout the time allotted. Please pick up all debris generated by your booth and remove it from the site or ensure it is place in the provided trash cans.
- Vendors assume all responsibility for any losses of property or money from the site. We recommend sites not be left unattended.
- We do not require knowledge of what is being sold therefore it is the vendor's responsibility to have knowledge of any TN State laws concerning items allowed to sell or not.
- The sale and use of alcohol is prohibited
- Animals, including dogs, must be restrained or caged at all times.
- **Participants are responsible for carrying their own liability insurance in the amount they deem appropriate. McMinn County and RUD are not responsible for any times damaged while on the property. Please take appropriate action to secure this insurance if you are concerned.**
- Professional conduct is expected. Please no yelling, swearing or threatening of customers, vendors or staff. This includes advertisement, signs or social media.
